

DARTS

Supplies: Pennies
Set of counters
Game board
Tally sheet
Pencil

Goal: To have the larger number at the end of each round.

Basic Game

Each player has three pennies to toss onto the target. As the first player throws a penny onto the board, the opponent keeps track of the score with counters. At the end of the first player's turn, the counters are totaled and the score is recorded on the tally sheet.

The second player takes a turn throwing the pennies one at a time and the opponent keeps track of the score with counters. The second player totals up the counters and records the score on the tally sheet. The larger of the two numbers is circled and the play continues.

Extensions

1. Increase the number of pennies thrown.
2. Using three pennies, pick a target number between 3 and 12.
