

Features of Non Fiction Text






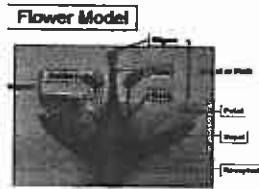
<p><u>Title</u> – tells us the name of the article or book.</p>	 <p>Abraham Lincoln</p>
<p><u>Illustration</u></p>	
<p><u>Photograph</u></p>	
<p><u>Caption</u> – tells us about the picture.</p>	 <p><i>This is a picture of a ladybug resting on a flower.</i></p>
<p><u>Chart</u> – organizes information</p>	

Diagram –names the different parts of something.



Label – tells the name of something



Time Line – tells us when things happened.
