Fiction

They usually have drawings, not photographs.

They can have some information. (Some facts)

They tell a story!

They have:

- Characters
- Settings
- Problems and Resolutions

They often have dialogue

They might have magical things happen.

It's NOT all about learning something.

Both

Both have details.

Both usually have drawings or photographs.

Most usually have words or writing (some don't).

Nonfiction

They usually have photographs, and sometimes drawings.

They give you real facts.

They never have magical things.

They usually don't have dialogue.

They are all about something you want to learn (topic)

They might have a story as part of the information.

They are all about learning something.
